Have you been reading all the news about Burkina Faso? In the last four years, this peaceful country has had terrorists taking over the land. The jihadis want to take total control of the government and establish an Islamic state with sharia law. Already they have control of 1/3 of the country and 800,000 Burkina people are refugees in their own land! Houses and villages are being burned down and many Christians are being killed!

But we are privileged to have front seats to see what God is doing! We have five churches in the most dangerous areas and so their members have been taken to safer areas and are spending three months of intensive literacy training, so they can read the Bible in their own language. They are all illiterate and so are most of the terrorists. But they are learning that God cares enough about them to speak to them in their own language! Pray that God will

help them to become good students. Several people have donated money to help two of these churches, but who helped the other three churches? Did you give some funds that were just for general needs? Probably some of your money went to this great project!



The Atlanta Chinese Christian churches raised more than \$60,000 to purchase property for a new school. This school was in a small rented facility and in a neighborhood that is 99% nonchristian and very expensive. Thank you, dear brothers and sisters! All the children have done well in their studies and many children and adults have accepted Christ.

We have another school in a similar neighborhood. \$30,000 has been raised so far. Would you like to help raise the other \$30,000?

We have seen so many answers to prayer during 2019-2020. We have

Bethesda, a home for widows and orphans. It is now too crowded and we needed two-bedroom apartments for mothers with both boys and girls. We prayed and waited, and in just the right time, we received the money for property and construction for Bethesda II. Praise God!



Here is a family that will be moving in as soon as construction is finished. Her husband died of AIDS in 2017, and she is sick also. In addition to the two little ones, she has two older children who are already in the sponsorship program. We are so happy we can care for widows and orphans, just as Scripture commands.

One of the ways Dr. Moussa encourages believers spread throughout 19 churches in Burkina Faso is through regional conferences. February 27 through March 2, in a small village, a Bible conference was held. It was attended by people who only speak a local language and have very little education. The location is in a dangerous area 270 miles from Dr. Moussa's home. Going there took a long time on unpaved roads.

The next regional conference is less than 3 miles from Moussa's home, but it is in the local language and mostly for rural people. They are grateful to be together and to be blessed by the Lord (Psalm 133).

Then finally in August the regional conference will be in French and will be in Bobo-Dioulasso. Bobo is the second largest city in Burkina Faso and is the hub of the ministry.

So, lots for us to pray for and to thank the Lord for.
