Child sponsorship is a God-blessed ministry. You can see the academic and spiritual growth of the child you sponsor through the special communications and photos that will be sent to you. Adama came from a very poor, Muslim family but through the special Bible classes for sponsored children, he accepted Christ as his Savior. He was a very good student and when he finished secondary school, he was accepted into medical school. While he studies, he is attending church and working with the Youth Bible Club. Burkina Faso provides tuition for medical school, but in return, he will be required to work in a Burkina hospital after he graduates, for a certain period of time. Different Ways to Donate: Child Sponsorship Program

We have over 5,000 students attending our seven elementary schools and three secondary schools. We only have sponsors for 150 children, so we are including a sponsorship brochure so you can enroll in the sponsorship program. If you send a \$30 check along with your filled-out brochure, and you will receive a mini-bio and photo of the child you are sponsoring. Then you can choose how you will pay \$30 a month. Some people pay \$360 all at once, some use our automatic money transfer from their banks, some use the WACM Chase Bank automatic pay system, and some use PayPal.



Discipleship

Discipleship is a very important part of the ministry. Adults who come to Christ are encouraged to attend the Elim Bible Institute for three years of classes. Dr. Moussa is the director and teacher of this program. From this program come pastors, church planters, teachers, and other committed Christians. The church planters and pastors are spread throughout the country, so regional conferences are held for pastors and any others who want to attend.

In-depth teaching, praying, singing, and planning for outreach are all included in the conferences which last for several days. Please pray for these regional conferences and pray especially for the five pastors ministering in the areas overtaken by the terrorists. Cell towers and telephone lines have been destroyed by the terrorists, so it is very difficult to communicate with these brave ministers of the Gospel.

A church, then a school!

We are in the midst of building a school in Dedougou Province. It began with a grant which was used to build a solar-powered well with a tall water tank for water storage. Previously, people had to walk three miles for water so they were happy to begin attending a church which was soon built. Building a school in this area will provide a safe area for families fleeing the violence and closed schools in the terrorists' territory. On the right is a picture of the Dedougou Church.



A Coup in Burkina Faso

You may have heard that there was a coup in Burkina Faso earlier this year. The entire time the deposed president was in office, the terrorists were taking over the country. The soldiers were very poorly equipped; sometimes not even having enough to eat. The military ended up taking over the government. Please pray for our brothers and sisters in Burkina Faso under these very difficult circumstances.
