Now that the Covid pandemic has wound down for a while, we were extremely thankful to be able to welcome Brother Moussa back to the United States to update and encourage his supporters and friends. For those of us who were able to see him, hopefully we were able to encourage and uplift him as well. There have been substantial changes in the country of Burkina Faso, but first I would like to discuss some changes here as well.

There are three main items of importance we need to alert you to:

- I. Child sponsorship has been \$30/month per child beginning in 2005. Since then, there has been a famine, terrible inflation, plus other occurrences causing prices to rise. In order to be effective in 2023 and beyond, we have agreed that \$40/month is more realistic in terms of supporting those who need it. If you currently give \$30/month and the added money would be a burden to you, the \$30/month you originally committed to will remain. We have gratefully received extra donations every month which go towards filling in those gaps. Please contact me with any questions regarding this.



The child sponsorship program only supports 150 of those students but we now have a goal to add 50 new child sponsors each year, starting with 2023. Last year we were informed that the school in Solenzo (#3 on map) was closed due to terrorists in the area and then we heard that the construction of the Dedougou school (#24 on map) was not completed in time. In the meantime, Moussa had brought the teachers and some of the students from Solenzo to the unfinished Dedougou school. *But what to do?* God led Moussa to rent a school on the north side of Dedougou. Since the school year ended, the terrorists seem to have left the area and the Dedougou school has been completed.





Sita is in the child sponsorship program. She wants us to pray that God will help all those who are suffering from hunger. She prays that God will bless the child sponsors in all their activities and that God will grant them a long life.

There is much we can be thankful for; there is also much to be in prayer for.
